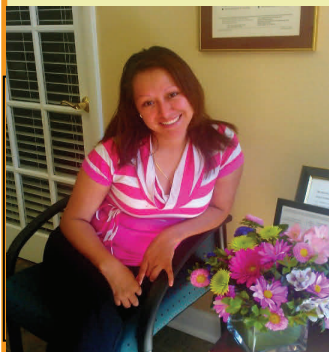
Site Director's Greeting

Dear Residents,

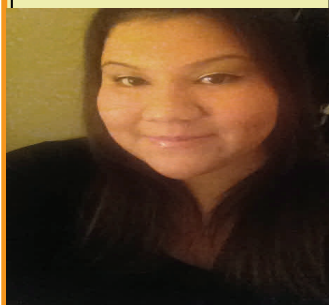

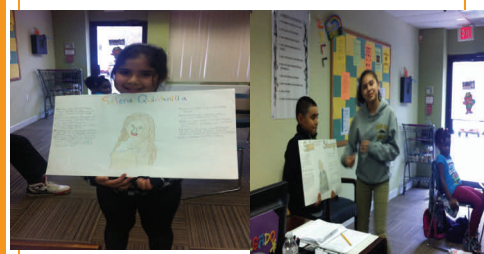
During March:
